DESCRIPTION OF WORK:	The project shall consist of providing all materials, equipment and labor necessary to install the work as defined as follows: 228LF of 30-inch wide PCC Curb and Gutter, 519SY of 9-inch thick HMA Pavement, 66SY of HMA Railroad Approach Pavement, 58SY of 4-inch thick and 6-inch thick PCC sidewalk, Detectable Warnings, Painted Pavement Markings and Symbols, Removals, Mobilization, Railroad Protective Insurance, and other associated appurtenances and miscellaneous work items. Contractor shall coordinate and work with Railroad work crews. All Work and equipment is to be in accordance with the Plans, Specifications and Contract Documents on file with the City Clerk of the City of Oxford, Iowa, which are by this reference made a part of this Notice as though fully set out and incorporated herein.
SALES TAX EXEMPTION	The Bidder is eligible to receive an exemption from the State of Iowa Sales Tax. The City expects the Contractor to obtain the Sales Tax Exemption from the City. State of Iowa Sales Tax shall <u>NOT</u> be included in the bid.
PREFERENCE	By virtue of statutory authority, a preference will be given to products and provisions grown and coal produced within the state of Iowa.
BID GUARANTY:	Bid security in the form of a cashier's check or certified check drawn on a state-chartered or federally chartered bank, or a certified share draft drawn on a state-chartered or federally chartered credit union, or a bidder's bond with corporate surety satisfactory to the City, in the amount of 10% of the bid.
COMPLETION DATE:	Work shall commence within ten (10) calendar days after receipt of the written "Notice to Proceed". All work shall be completed by July 15, 2023 subject to any time extension that may be granted by the Council.
PERFORMANCE/ PAYMENT /MAINTENANCE BOND:	One hundred percent (100%) of the bid, with a maintenance period of two (2) years from the time of final project acceptance by the Owner.
PAYMENTS:	Monthly estimates equivalent to ninety-five percent (95%) of the Contract value of the work completed during the preceding calendar month with 5% retainage. Remaining retainage, if any, will be paid within 30 days after final acceptance by the City.
